Go down from the temple past the lone tress, don't leave the town, go into the building left of the town exit. Talk to the man behind the counter, he is the shopkeeper, he gives you an "Apple". Leave the shop and go back to Chester's house, and up the stairs to the top floor and talk to Ami to give her the "Apple". Leave Chester's house and try to exit the town (the exit is south of the building where you received the Apple). You will see a scene with Tristan. Now exit the town and your on the world map. Now head to the South Forest, to get there head south around the mountain and you automatically enter the forest. You will encounter many enemies in here, it is worth fighting all of them. Go left all the way, then down until you see the boar, then go to down a bit and left through the opening, then up and right and you will find a chest with a "Life Bottle". Go back to where you saw the boar, then go all the way down from there. Then go right and you will see the boar again, continue all the way right. Then all the way up and you come to a large tree, you see a scene. After which the boar attacks you.

Go up, then right, then down and touch the sword you see. You will get a "Knight's Saber", equip it as it is much stronger than your current weapon. Leave Cress' house and exit the town. Now you are on the world map.
