FAQ:

Q:Hey, where can I download Zoids Saga?

A:Find it for yourself. As if giving out and asking for ROMs on GameFAQs wasn't bad enough, they are completely illegal and I have no desire to be involved with illegal activities of any kind. Any email regarding such will be deleted, and as will any messages on the GameFAQs Zoids Saga board.

A:Because this is a guide for Zoids Saga. Zoids Saga only has 143 different playable Zoids, plus a few others that cannot be used.

Q:What's katakana?

A:It's the dialect of Japanese that Zoid names are written in and the simplest form of Japanese.

Q:Why include Japanese in an English guide?

A:Because the game is only available in Japanese and this guide is for those who don't know any Japanese.

Q:Are you certain these names are right?

A:Absolutely, unless I've noted otherwise. 99% of these are official names.

Zoid Names:

Notes:This is the majority of the guide, names of the various mecha known as Zoids. All the names with a few exceptions are written entirely in katakana in the game, and as such I've included a romanized version of the katakana for the name. I've also taken the liberty to list name variations and origins. In the future, I'd like to make this document in Shift JIS to make it easier to identify Zoids and characters.

Name Origins:A liger is a cat born from a male lion and a female tiger(which is odd since Shield Liger is a "lion" type) and Shield Liger's primary feature is its energy shield.

Name Origins:Mk is short for Mark, which essentially means version. So basically, Mk II means version 2.

Name Origins:Zero is a "power" word in anime with many different meanings. In this case it just means unique and powerful.

Name Origins:Jager is German for hunter, and yes it is pronounced "yay-ger".

Name Origins:Schneider is German for tailor and cutter.

Liger Zero PA

Katakana:Raiga Zero Panja

Variations:Pantzer(unofficial)

Name Origins:Panzer is German for both armor and tank.

Name Origins:X is another "power" word in anime, which always means great power.

Name Origins:Irvine is the pilot of this Command Wolf variant. Oddly though, the

Command Wolf Irvine in the anime doesn't have the rifle. Instead, the version with the rifle is the Command Wolf Irvine Long Range Rifle.

Name Origins:Spread Missiles are it's primary weapon, and SM is short for that.

Name Origins:Unknown. This is probably the biggest mystery of Zoids.

Name Origins:S is for super and/or special. This particular Gojulas is based on a limited edition version of the Gojulas Mk II in the original Japanese line of Zoids model kits.

Name Origins:Mk II.

Gojulas The Ogre

Name Origins:An ogre is a mythological creature possessing great strength, much more than any animal. Gojulas The Ogre is the ogre of Gojulas's.

Variations:Gojulas Gana/Gojulas Ganna(unofficial)

Name Origins:It's got guns, so I don't think I really NEED to explain where the name comes from...

Gojulas AS

Variations:Gojulas The Ogre Irvine(anime)

Name Origins:Irvine's Gojulas. It's AS because in Japan, Irvine's name starts with an A.

Ultrasaurus

Name Origins:Ultrasaurus is what a supersaurus fossil found in 1985 was originally called. At first it was believed it was a new species, but in fact it was just a larger supersaurus.

Name Origins:Unknown.

Name Origins:"Radome" is short for "radar dome." In addition, "radar" is short for "radio and receiver."

Heavy Iron ? Godos

Variations:Heavy Armor Godos

Name Origins:Again, beats me.

Gun Sniper

Name Origins:A sniper is a sharpshooter

skilled in being undetected.

Variations:Gun Sniper WW(anime)

Name Origins:W2 is short for Wild Weasel,

the upgrade this Gun Sniper features.

Gun Sniper LS

Katakana:Gan Sunaipa LS(Rinon Specification)

Variations:N/A

Name Origins:Rinon is the pilot of this fearsome

Gun Sniper. Oddly, the Japanese name for Leena

is Rinon but it's still labeled LS.

Gun Sniper NS

Name Origins:Naomi Fluegel's Gun Sniper.

Iron Kong

Name Origins:King Kong is a famous giant gorilla, thus make it metal and you have Iron Kong.

Name Origins:Same as Gojulas Mk II S.

Name Origins:All I have to say is that I'd love to know what PK stands for...

Variations:Iron Kong Schubaltz(anime)

Name Origins:Colonel Karl Lichen Schubaltz is the pilot of this variant.

Iron Kong MA

Katakana:Aian Kongu MA(Maneuver)

Variations:N/A

Name Origins:Maneuver is referencing the CP-10 Maneuver Thruster Unit that most Iron Kong types have. However, this variant is significantly faster.

Red Horn

Name Origins:This one's a no-brainer.

Red Horn BG

Katakana:Reddo Hon Bimu Gatoringu

Variations:N/A

Name Origins:BG is short for Beam Gatling.

Red Horn BG is armed with the CP-03 Beam Gatling Unit, so the name is very logical.

Dark Horn

Name Origins:Another no-brainer.

Name Origins:Harry Champ's custom Dark Horn.

Name Origins:The name is obviously derived from elephant.

Name Origins:SC is short for scout. In military terms, a scout is a unit sent out to note the current battlefield conditions.

Variations:Sabre Tiger Raven(anime)

Name Origins:Raven's Sabre Tiger.

Sabre Tiger SS

Katakana:Seiba Taiga Shubarutsu(Specification)

Variations:Sabre Tiger Schubaltz(anime)

Name Origins:Schubaltz's Sabre Tiger.

Sabre Tiger AT

Katakana:Seiba Taiga(Assault Type)

Variations:Great Sabre

Name Origins:The weapon mounted on the back
of this variant is the CP-02 Assault Unit.

Name Origins:FT is short for Fight.

Name Origins:S is short for silver, the color of this variant.

Variations:N/A

Name Origins:G is short for gold, the color of this variant.

Variations:None.

Name Origins:Gail's custom Sabre Tiger.

Helcat

Variations:Atak Kat(Hasbro)

Name Origins:I do believe a helcat is a mythological creature, but I don't remember...Otherwise, the name could come from the World War II fighter plane the F6F Hellcat. The Hellcat was a step up from the F3F Wildcat, and it's six machine guns gave it's enemies hell.

Lightning Saix

Variations:None.

Name Origins:Lightning is very fast and the name implies that it is fast. I have no clue what saix means though.

Name Origins:There are two different versions of Zoids Saga it seems. One has this Zoid labeled Lightning Saix A and the other Lightning Saix AS. I have no idea what A is for, but AS is for Irvine Specification.

Variations:Lightning Saix BS

Name Origins:Unknown. This also changes with which version of Zoids Saga you are playing.

Dark Spiner

Name Origins:Dark implies evil, and spiner is derived from spinosaurus. So Dark Spiner means evil spinosaurus.

Dark Spiner DCS
Katakana:Daku Supaina(DCS)
Variations:None.

Name Origins:The same as Shield Liger DCS I do believe, but I'm not sure what that is either...

Gator:
Katakana:Geta
Variations:Gatordus (Hasbro)

Name Origins:Gator is possibly short for alligator, but it may mean something else.

Gator Radome S
Katakana:Geta Redomu(S)
Variations:None.

Name Origins:Radar dome.

Death Saurer

Katakana:Desu Zaura

Variations:None.

Name Origins:Death implies that it is deadly and saurer is derived from -saurus.

Bloody Demon

Katakana:Buraddi Demon

Variations:Buratsudeidoomon(wrong translation)

Name Origins:Bloody implies that it is a vicious killer and a demon is an evil creature, usually from Hell or an equivalent.

Geno Saurer

Katakana:Jeno Zaura

Variations:Genosaurus(New Century /Zero dub)

Name Origins:Geno is short for genocide. Also, there was a carnivorous dinosaur named genusaurus. At the moment I'm not certain as to whether or not genusaurus is significant.

Psycho Geno Saurer

Katakana:Saiko Jeno Zaura

Variations:None.

Name Origins:The term psycho is generally used as a noun meaning a person who is insane. I do believe that this time it's being used as an adjective in reference to Reese's psychic-like powers.

Super Geno Saurer

Katakana:Supa Jeno Zaura

Variations:None.

Name Origins:Super implies that it is improved.

Geno Saurer BS

Katakana:Jeno Zaura Buraddo(Specification)

Variations:None.

Name Origins:Blood's custom Geno Saurer.

Geno Scissors

Katakana:Jeno Shizasu

Variations:None.

Name Origins:Unknown.

Geno Trooper

Katakana:Jeno Torupa

Variations:None.

Name Origins:Trooper is most likely short for paratrooper.

Geno Breaker

Katakana:Jeno Bureika

Variations:None.

Name Origins:Unknown.

Geno Breaker RS

Katakana:Jeno Bureika Reivn(Specification)

Variations:None.

Name Origins:Raven's Geno Breaker.

Proto Breaker

Katakana:Puroto Bureika

Variations:None.

Name Origins:Proto is short for prototype.

Rev Rapter

Katakana:Rebu Raputa

Variations:Rev Raptor(USA)

Name Origins:Rapter is a misspelling of raptor. I surmise that rev may be a misspelled, shortened version of rebel.

Rev Rapter PB

Katakana:Rebu Raputa Pairu Banka

Variations:N/A

Name Origins:PB is short for Pile Banker, the name of the large drill-like weapon on this variant.

Marda

Katakana:Mada

Variations:Merda/Hellrunner (unofficial)

Name Origins:Unknown.

Iguan

Katakana:Iguan

Variations:Iguanasaur (Hasbro)

Name Origins:Iguan is short for iguanodon.

Redler

Katakana:Redora

Variations:Reddra (original name)

Name Origins:Redler is an alternate spelling of Reddra, which is short for red dragon. I have no idea why Redler is purple though...

Redler IC

Katakana:Redora Intaseputa

Variations:None.

Name Origins:IC is short for interceptor, which roughly means fighter plane.

Redler BC

Katakana:Redora Busuta Kyanon

Variations:Redler Booster Cannon (anime)

Name Origins:BC is short for Booster Cannon, the sole weapon of this variant.

Black Redler

Katakana:Burakku Redora

Variations:None.

Name Origins:It's black instead of red or purple.

Berserk Fuhrer

Katakana:Bazaku Fura

Variations:Berserk Fury(USA)

Name Origins:Fuhrer is German for leader. This is quite appropriate seeing as how the Berserk Fuhrer led the Backdraft group in the New Century /Zero anime.

Berserk Fuhrer Y

Katakana:Bazaku Fura(Y)

Variations:None.

Name Origins:This is a CAS variant of Berserk Fuhrer, and the name is probably an extension of a Liger Zero CAS variant(X). With Liger Zero X, Berserk Fuhrer Y, and Berserk Fuhrer Z, you would have the last three letters of the alphabet. Then again, Y may stand for something but at the moment I am not certain.

Name Origins:X-Y-Z.

Variations:Berserk Fuhrer Storm

Name Origins:The armor of this CAS variant is called Storm, probably because of the large thrusters on the back.

Salamander

Variations:Pteramander(Hasbro)

Name Origins:A salamander is a mythological creature that is immune to fire(not to be confused with lizards called salamanders), which is appropriate since it's primary

weapon is a flamethrower.

Salamander F2

Katakana:Saramanda (F2)

Variations:Salamander F-2

Name Origins:Some decals that are in the Salamander model kit have F-1 written on them. The F-2 variant is a much faster upgrade.

Salamander FS

Katakana:Saramanda Furan (Specification)

Variations:None.

Name Origins:Fran's custom Salamander.

Trinity Liger

Katakana:Toriniti Raiga

Variations:None.

Name Origins:Trinity is another "power" word in anime. A trinity is a group of three acting as one. Trinity Liger is nearly three times as powerful as other ligers.

Trinity Liger BA

Katakana:Trinity Liger Bainingu Ama

Variations:None.

Name Origins:BA is short for Burning Armor. What does Burning Armor mean? Beats me.

Geno Hydra

Katakana:Jeno Haidora

Variations:Geno Haidora (unofficial)

Name Origins:A hydra is a nine-headed monster from Greek mythology that was slain by Hercules. Geno Hydra only has two heads though.

Geno Hydra KA

Katakana:Jeno Haidora Kiru Ama

Variations:Geno Haidora KA(unofficial)

Name Origins:KA is short for Kill Armor.

Geno Hydra KA is great at killing armor, so...

Cannon Tortoise

Katakana:Kyanon Totasu

Variations:N/A

Name Origins:A tortoise is a reptile similar to a turtle, but not aquatic and much slower.

Cannon Tortoise Heavy Gun Specification

Katakana:Kyanon Totasu(Heavy Gun Specification)

Variations:Cannon Tortoise Assault Type(unofficial)

Name Origins:Unknown. IIRC, this variant's main gun is less powerful than that of a normal Cannon Tortoise...

Cannon Tortoise BC

Variations:Cannon Tortoise Heavy Gun(anime)

Name Origins:This time BC is short for Beam Cannon, as in the CP-05 Heavy Beam Cannon Unit that Cannon Tortoise BC is armed with.

Variations:None.

Name Origins:Opisu's custom Cannon Tortoise.

Name Origins:This variant's primary weapon is the CP-06 Cannory Unit. The Cannory Unit is as big as the Molga itself, which is why it's Cannory Molga and not Molga Cannory.

Variations:Hammerhead
Name Origins:Hammer head shark.

Hammer Head VL
Katakana:Hanma Hedo Baikingu Ransu
Variations:Hammerhead VL

Name Origins:VL is short for Viking Lance, the main upgrade this variant sports.

Wardick

Katakana:Wodikku

Variations:War Shark(USA)

Name Origins:Unknown. Perhaps Wardick is a scientific name for a coelacanth?

Death Stinger

Katakana:Desu Sutinga

Variations:None.

Name Origins:Scorpions have stingers, and so does Death Stinger(which is a sea scorpion type of Zoid).

Death Stinger OS

Katakana:Desu Sutinga Opisu(Specificiation)

Variations:None.

Name Origins:Opisu's custom Death Stinger.

Shadow Fox

Katakana:Shadou Fokusu

Variations:None.

Name:Origins:Shadow implies stealth, which Shadow Fox is meant for. And fox is obvious since Shadow Fox is a fox type Zoid.

Heldigunner

Variations:Hel Digunner(Hasbro)

Name Origins:Hell D Gunner. Hell implies that it's a pain to fight, D is short for digital, and Gunner is self-explanatory.
