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I N T R O D U C T I O N

Hi, my name is Christiana Bakarich, and I welcome you to this massive project I've undertaken. Tales of Symphonia is the first RPG I have played on the GameCube. I adored it, and put in, over a period of three months, at least 400 hours. It's a great game.

Lloyd: Huh? What do we have?

Genis: Love and courage!

Lloyd: Hey! Regal wouldn't be thinking of something common and silly like that!

Regal: ...Common and silly...hmm...

239 "Smile and Forgive"

Colette: Thank you, Presea.

Presea: ...For what?...

Colette: For rescuing me.

Presea: ...But it was my fault you were kidnapped. So...

Colette: Huh?

Sheena: There's something strange about this city...but I can't put my finger on it.

Regal: There are many people here, but there is no feeling of actual

daily life activity. That's probably why.

Sheena: Yeah... They're alive, but it's like they're dead. They aren't thinking anything at all...

Regal: So it would seem...

Sheena: What Cruxis is doing is just wrong.

267 "Genis Disturbed"

Lloyd: Man, Welgaia was quite a place, wasn't it!

Genis: ...Y...yeah...
