=== Alternate Title Screen ===

Highlight 'Players' in the option menu and press the start button. Re-enter the options menu and highlight 'Players' again, then enter: A, A, A, A, C, A. The title screen will now display 'Road Blaster FX,' and 'Options' will now be known as 'Config.'

=== Debug Mode ===

Highlight 'Players' in the option menu and enter: C, C, C, C. During gameplay, press A+B+C.

=== Demo Mode ===

Highlight 'Players' in the option menu and enter: A, A, A, A, A, B.

=== Enable Pause ===

Highlight 'Players' in the option menu and enter: A, A, A, A, B. The game can now be paused by pressing the start button.

=== Level Select ===

Highlight 'Players' in the option menu and enter: A, A, A, A, A, A.

=== Level Skip ===

Enter the 'Enable Pause' code, then go back and enter the following in the same place: A, A, A, A, B, A. Pause the game and press C to skip levels.
