1) Introduction

Hi, and welcome to my first faq/ guide ever, which will be covering the wyvern Monoblos in the excellent game Monster Hunter
Freedom. Before I get started, I'd like to cover a few things. First off, this is my first faq. I'd like constructive criticism, which means pointing a flaw, and making a suggestion. NOT "zomg u r teh suxzorz". Secondly, I'll give credit where it's due. If you email me with a strategy that helped you beat him, you'll gain a place in the acknowledgements section of this guide. Lastly, if I missed anything, I'd like you to email me with what I missed (such as carves, an attack, etc) and you'll get an acknowledgement. I think that's it as far as the introduction goes, have fun and remember, only you can prevent forest fires!

Dragon - 2 Thunder - 5

There is a regular Monoblos and a White one. They share the same elemental stats. The only difference between the two is White Monoblos is faster, does more damage, and has more HP.

Sonic Bombs are your friend. As long as he isn't in fury mode, after he digs, you can throw a sonic bomb and he'll pop out half-way, similar to getting a different creature stuck in a Pitfall Trap.

Pitfall Traps won't work on either version of Monoblos, so don't try to use them on him. Flash Bombs rarely work, but bring them in case you need to sharpen a weapon or reload a gun.

If Black Smoke comes out of his mouth and red stripes appear on his "forehead", it means he's in fury mode. This means he'll move faster, do more damage, and generally be a huge pain-in-the-ass until he calms down.

In areas 1 and 10, there's a ledge you can climb on. What you want to do is climb on the ledge, then have Monoblos dash at you. He'll get stuck for a small amount of time, allowing you some free hits. Keep in mind that after so many hits on his head, his horn will break and you'll be unable to get him stuck again.

## 3) Attacks

Dash - Monoblos will run at you, potentially dealing a large amount of damage. If you block, you'll take no damage, and you may get a chance to attack depending on where he stops. As a warning, he'll put one foot back, roar slightly, then lurch ahead. It deals a large amount of damage compared to most of his other attacks.

Bite - Monoblos will attempt to bite you, even if you're at the other side of the area. It's easily blockable (or dodgable) so you should be able to get several good hits in. As a warning, he'll turn slowly, similar to the way Rathalos turns right before he launches a fireball. This does a small amount of damage compared to a lot of his other attacks.

Scream - Monoblos will scream, temporarily disabling you for a medium period of time. This can be blocked, which is very useful considering it gives him just enough time to attack you once. It does no damage, but puts you in a position for him to deal some.

Dig - This attack is barely dangerous at all. He'll dig into the ground, taking about 5 seconds. If you're close to him, you'll get hit by wind, if you're really close, you'll take a small amount of damage. This attack leads up to.....

Emerge - Directly after dig, he'll jump up out of the ground, dealing a large amount of damage if you're hit. The best way to avoid it is to A) Get next to a wall and block, or B) Keep rolling/ diving. Generally one of these two will save you.

Tail Swing - He simply turns, keeping his tail erect, trying to hit you. As long as you don't get hit, you should be able to get some free hits, it does minimal damage.

Tail Slam - He hits the ground twice with his tail. Once on his right, once on his left. Unless you're in front of him, you will get hit. It does enough damage to be concerned if you have any less than 100 defense.

4) Great Sword Training

Equipment

Weapon - Sieglinde

Head - Expert Piercing

Torso - Plesioth Mail

Arms - Monoblos Vambraces

Belt - Chrome Metal Coat

Legs - Chrome Metal Boots

Strategy - Take both Rations, then run through areas 1 and 4, and enter area 10. When you see Monoblos, get in his face, and as soon as notices you, throw a paintball. Once he's marked, get up on the ledge and hug the back of it until he dashes and gets stuck. Start attacking him with your weapon. Keep doing this until his horn is broken. If he's in rage mode after his horn his broken, stay on the ledge and attack his head. Once he's normal again, jump down, and wait for him to dig.

Throw a Sonic Bomb, and unload on him. Once he gets free, run back on the ledge and see if he goes into rage mode. If he is, stay on the ledge and attack his head. Once he's normal again, jump down, and wait for him to dig. Throw a Sonic Bomb, and once again unload on him.

At this point he should have less than half health. Just keep attacking him cautiously until he's dead, using Mega Potions when needed. Once he's dead, give yourself a pat on the back, then get ready for....

Weapon - Titan Launcher

Head - Rathalos Soul Cap

Torso - Rathalos Soul Vest

Arms - Black Belt Vambraces

Belt - Velociprey Coat

Legs - Blue Pants

Strategy

First off, take two Rations, then switch to Clust S Lv3 and load. Enter areas 1 and 4, then area 10, where Monoblos is.

Notice your auto-tracking armor? It'll help you to see where he is under the sand. Anyways, get on the cliff in area 10 before firing a shot. Use your bullets in this order:

Clust S Lv3
Clust S Lv2
Crag S Lv3
Crag S Lv2
Pierce S Lv2
Pellet S Lv2

You shouldn't need to use even half of the Pierces to bring him down. Just stay on the cliff as much as possible, and avoid getting hit. If me moves to area 4, go ahead and enter, but be careful. You won't have a ledge to save yourself, so you need to time exactly when to fire and reload.

When challenging a Monoblos, the best tactic is to aim for one leg at a time. If he's in a zone with a ledge, hit his face. When he digs underground, roll away when near him, and apply a strike to his head or tail. I use raw damage, syntoryu wolf, no elemental stuff. When he gets into fury mode, the best way to attack him is when he gets through charging, or from the front

Also, I dont reccomend running\rolling when he charges, guarding, then attacking when he has his guard down is better.
