Huh, this is the kind of game I believe was only made for the true fans. Cool graphics, events related to the manga/anime occur in the middle of the matches, really good animated sequences and most of the characters included (even a weird Tsubasa "clone" than I don't know...) but some things that mess everything up... I was wrong before, it appears the game is not in real time, but the music may get somehow boring after playing for so much time. Apart from that, and if you are a real fan, you must have it.

### 1. Basic Info

Since this is a strategy game, just pick your options from the menu in japanese (well, you don't need to know japanese, just look at the where the arrows point) and do as good as you can. Scoring is quite easy, just strike (for striking, pass the ball to someone inside the goal area...

for special shots is almost the same) and you will get a goal most of the times.

You must have noticed there are some bars below each of the character's face, well, that's their "energy", which is required in order to perform certain specials.

A really important thing, "TIE AND DIE", I mean, if you tie it will be the same as loosing the match, by some strange reason...

Before each match you'll see some japanese characters in a white suite, well, they can be added to your team in the next match.

I was almost forgetting, at a certain time you will see "Captain Command", that's a feature which will make one of your characters bar increase a lot; just pick the character you want choosing from the

pictures, if you don't know japanese at all.

#### 2. Walkthrough

Hum, this is just one of the paths you can follow... After the second and forth match you will be able to choose from 2 different paths, that will determine what will be the players you will earn on next matches.

#### Japan vs Thailand

This game stars with a quite easy match, you don't have most of Japan stars but those players you have are more than enough to handle the opponent. Tsubasa's specials are a sure goal, but so are the shots from those 3 Shutetsu folks (Izawa, Kisugi and Taki) and the Tachibana Brothers one.

At a certain time a event will occur (maybe on the beggining of the 2nd half, but I'm not sure) and Thailand's players will start moving quite good, finshing with a special shot. Morisaki isn't able to stop it, but don't bother about it, they won't use it anymore, so you can score as many goals as you want to make your victory even better.

# Japan vs Mexico

Easy match, just strike as much as you can, don't bother with all those special players, their GK Espadas isn't so good as we could think, from the manga.

# Japan vs China

Try to score as much as possible in the 1st term, since in the 2nd term their best player will get into play. For having some fun, put Hyuga into play on the 2nd term, when we confronts the Chinese Hero they will have a shot fight and you will be scored (well, Morisaki has a chance of catching this shot if he uses a special catch, which requires the full bar) with an amazing Dragon Shot. Tsubasa will be stolen the ball by this new player, but Hyuga will recover it with his Tiger Tackle.

# Japan vs Saudi Arabia

The worst match up to know... Their Gk may be good sometimes (he stopped Hyuga's Tiger Overhead Shot) but the opponent seems to be able to intercept most of your passes. You should use the Tachibana Twins' and Taki's specials for advance on the field and for scoring use Hyuga and Tsubasa. It's better to use 1 "Captain Command" on Morisaki so that he will be able to use his special catch when the opponent team uses their special strike.

## Japan vs Sweden

This team's pretty good! First switch Hyuga for Kisugi, since Hyuga won't be of much help, with a player always stopping him from scoring

with Raiju Shot whenever he is reaching the goal area. Use the Tachibana Twins Gemini Combination (full bar required for both of them) for safely go up the field and you may finish by using Soda's Kamisori Shot (the 2nd option from the shots list) for scoring of simply pass the ball to Tsubasa for an easier chance of scoring. Don't care much about Levin, since he doesn't appear to use his own shot quite often.

## Japan vs Uruguay

Hino is better than he seems... His Dragon Shot may score even from the middle of the field, you must be really careful with him and also with Victorino, the "classic" star of this team, he seems only to have a simple "tackle shot" but it is quite effective. As for your GK, pick the bald one (sorry, I don't remember his name) since for some reason I don't understan Hino seems not to score him a goal quite often. As for striking, Tsubasa, Hyuga and Nitta seem to be good, with a small backup from Sawada which may combine with Huyga for Toho Combination.

### Japan vs Brazil

HUH! This is HOT, not only they have the best team I've seen up to the moment plus they have a beautiful game, just watch Naturezza's Overhead Shot and you will surely understand what I'm saying... Most of the times they pass the ball to Pepe (for those who don't know japanese, it looks something like " ^o^o ") and Santana will finish by scoring with a powered Drive Shot (well, this move has its own name, but I... don't recall it! :().

Their GK is really good, so don't forget to put Misaki into play so that he may combine with Tsubasa for a Twin Overhead Shot so that you have at least any chance of scoring, yeah, cause this is going to be hard!!! For scoring use essentially (ATENTION, NOT EVEN THIS MAY ALWAYS WORK) Hyuga's Rayju Shot, Tsubasa's Flying Drive Shot (is this the name of the move? I don't know...), Nitta's Falcon Volley or even Soda's Kamisori Shot, if you ever get the chance for it.

Watch out for Santana's Shots and those of Naturezza and maybe your chance of winning will be greater than you may have thought in the begginig.

# Japan vs Japan "Black"

Remember the team you made when you reached Japan? Well, you will be playing against the players you left out of the team, plus Wakabayashi (he isn't REALLY good) and Hino, who seems to be back. This is going to be a really easy match, just score with Hyuga and Tsubasa and you won't even notice anyone on the goal...

THIS IS THE LAST MATCH, however after finishing it you can save your game, which will enable you to start the game all over again but with the players you had at its ending... There may be some missing players, you can get them using this save, just play the game using the new savegame and when you are able to choose your path (for example, after the match against Mexico), choose one that you haven't chosen before.

# 4. Trick to get all the Movies/Pics

Hum, first you must try using getting all the players (Wakabayashi, Misaki, Hino and all the other folks) and reach the final stage, the one of Japan vs Japan "Black", then you must defeat them by a large score, like 6-0 and then save your game... after doing this, restart this same savegame and access the movies/images at the options screen, by doing so you will see all of them. But you ask, how can you get a large score against this japanese team? Easy... in the begginning of the level you will be able to choose who will be on your team, choose Wakabayashi for the goals (or Wakashimazu, if you don't have the first one) and also put Misaki/Tsubasa and Masao/Kazuo Tachibana in the field, so that they can use their great combinations to advance in the field. If possible, pass the ball to Hyuga or Hino and use Rayju Shot (for Hyuga) or Double Hurricane Shot (Hino's best shot) for a sure goal. Hope you win easily and by a large difference of goals for getting all those cool pics and movies... Well, in fact there is even an easier way to get all the movies... just use your gameshark and try watching the inside of the \*.bin files in the cd, one of them will have all the movies in it (hum, maybe its name is movies.bin , sorry but i don't remember the name of the file at all, just used it to check some moves early on).
