#### -- CARD NAMES --

Each card has a different name.

#### -- CARD LEVELS --

-----

Each card has its own level. A card's level determines on how strong or, how high your numbers go on your card. The levels go up to 1 - 10. A level 1 card is basically the weakest level, meaning a level 3 or 4 card will beat that card, having level 10 cards, the strongest cards of the game, can easily wipe out an level 1 - 7 card. However, the level 10 cards are very rare to get in the game.

#### -- GAME RULES --

-----

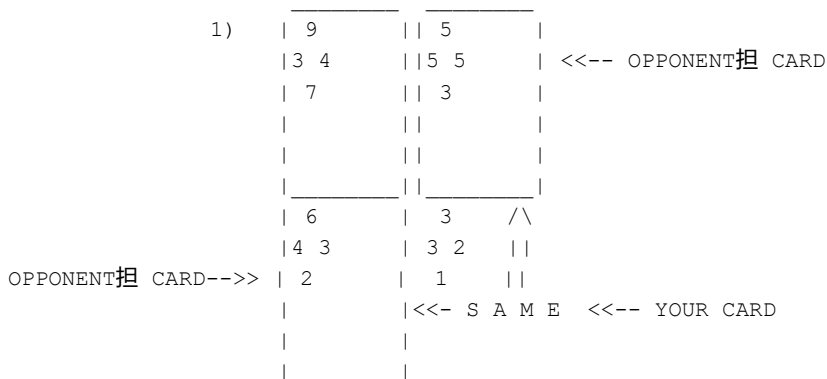
Card game rules are determined on how the game will be played. By playing people in different regions, the rules of that region or the region that you're going to pass on will be spread through that region. Like people say all the time, BEWARE OF SPREADING THE RANDOM RULE because you ARE most likely to lose your cards you don't want to lose.

OPEN:

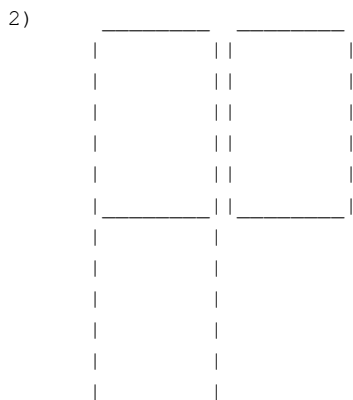
This rule is probably the easiest and coolest rule in the game (in my opinion). This rule will get you to a higher chance of winning a card game. Your opponent's cards are face upward so you can see them. This will help you on what card to place down so you can easily win!

SAME:

This rule can be complicated and needs a lot of focusing on the card game because if you are not careful the opponents card might flip over your card(s). Look at this drawing to give you a clue of the Same Rule.



\*\*\* NOTICE that the two 3痴 on your card is facing the SAME direction of your card? This is called a same.
