## Wheel of Fortune: 2nd Edition FAQ

## Introduction

The game contains two sections of gameplay: the main game and the final round. To get to the final round, a player must have the most money at the end of the main game. Throughout the main game there are sometimes multiple choice questions after the answer has been revealed, based on the category.

Some categories look very similar. For example, Thing and Things. These are actually two separate categories in the game.

Please note that the game was never played to acquire these categories \& answers. They were acquired through delving into the game's files. If you see any errors, please let the author know.

Trivia: There are eight unused categories: Events, Fictional Place, Foreign Word, Nickname, Person / Title, Proper Names, Slang, and Song / Artist

## How to Play

The goal of the game is to be the player with the highest money acquired by the end of the game. Doing so will allow you to go to the Final Round, where you will have a chance to win lots of money or a really good prize.

## Setting up the Game

The title screen has four options:

- Normal Game: Play a normal game of Wheel of Fortune, with other players and/or computer opponents
- Game Length: 20/15/10 Minutes or 5/4/3 Rounds
- Tournament Game:
- Solo Game: Play a game of Wheel of Fortune by yourself
- Game Length: 5/4/3 Rounds
- Contestant Exam
- Behind the Scenes: View various interview videos from the people who make the Wheel of Fortune television show
- Career Statistics: View high scores for various categories
- Options:
- Response Time: How long a player has to take an action (spin, pick a letter, answer the puzzle)

## Playing the Game

When it is your turn, you can spin the wheel by using Triangle. Next, you press $X$ to spin, and can hold the button in for more power. You may land on a special space if the round has one, Lose a Turn to have your turn skipped, Bankrupt to lose your round's money, or land on something with a dollar amount.

If you don't get Lose a Turn or Bankrupt, you will next have to choose a letter. The letters you can choose are consonants, and you will be told if the puzzle has any. If you do, you will receive an amount of money calculated by the following:

Money earned = Dollar amount landed on * Number of letters revealed.

If the letter you called does not exist for the puzzle, your turn is over. If it exists, you will get to go again.

By choosing Square, you can buy a vowel, but it requires $\$ 250$ and you don't get anything for doing this.
You can also solve the puzzle (even from the first turn) by choosing Circle.

## Special Rounds

Some rounds will have a follow-up multiple choice question once solved for the player who solved correctly. Answering the multiple choice question correctly will result in a bonus to the player's score.

## Letter Suggestions \& Frequency

It's always important to go with letters that make sense for the puzzle you are on. For example, if you see a $Q$, it almost always has a $U$ following it. If you see a full word and are missing the last letter, it's probably S (example: For the puzzle "Born To Be Wild Mushrooms", if you had the word Mushroom and a missing letter it would be the S.)

The following is the frequency the letters appear in the game. This is a percentage from the total number of letters for each game mode. It is split up into consonants and vowels.

Statistically, if you need to make a guess, go with the following:

- Main Game: T, R, N, and S combined make up almost half the consonants for all the main game's puzzles. E is the most common vowel at over $30 \%$ of vowels.
- Final Round: (This ignores the letters given by default). H, C, G, and B are the most common at about $45 \%$ combined for all consonants. A, I, and O are close in how common they are as vowels.
- Never go with rare letters on a guess: J, K, Q, V, X, Z.


## Contestant Exam

This mode always has the same 16 puzzles. If you pass (get at least 12 right), they will give you information on how to apply (at least back then) to be on the television show.
