CONTROLLER NEUTRAL POSITION RESET

If the L or R Buttons are pressed or the Control Stick or C Stick are moved out of neutral position when the power is turned on, those positions will be set as the neutral position, causing incorrect game control during game play.

To reset the controller, release all buttons and sticks to allow them to return to the correct neutral position, then hold down the X, Y and START/PAUSE Buttons simultaneously for 3 seconds.




NEW BEGINNINGS

Hold it greenhorn! Take a moment to review the basics about starting a farm before you trot off with that hoe and hurt someone. It might save you time and even prevent a mess or two!




Name Your Character






THE SCREEN SCENE

SORTING OUT INVENTORY


